

Troop 783 Camping Equipment List

Medical Requirements:

- Medical Form to Mrs. Purdy, updated annually
- Medications (MUST be given to adult in charge in original bottle with instructions)**

Equipment:

- Class A Scout uniform (MUST BE WORN WHILE TRAVELING)**
- Tent and ground cloth
- Sleeping bag rated for 20 degrees or less
- Sleeping pad
- Mess kit, utensils, cup
- Socks
- Underwear
- Extra set(s) of clothes, long pants
- Troop class "B" t-shirt
- Waterproof boots
- Fleece pants, jacket, hat and gloves for cold-weather sleeping
- Warm coat, gloves and hat
- Rain gear
- Towel
- Toiletries (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo)
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray (pump bottle – NO AEROSOLS allowed)
- Flashlight or headlamp, extra batteries
- Garbage bag for dirty laundry
- SCOUT HANDBOOK
- NOTEBOOK, pens or pencils
- Water bottle(s) to carry during the day
- Day pack for daytime use
- Waterproof watch
- Personal first-aid kit
- Backpack to pack all of the above
- Spending money, in case the driver stops for lunch on Sunday

Optional Equipment:

- Camera
- Compass
- Cards or games
- Spare rope
- Pillow
- Blanket
- Matches (MUST have Fireman's chit)
- Pocket knife (MUST have Toten' chip card)

Prohibited Equipment:

- Lighter or any kind of FLAMMABLE liquid or aerosols
- NO food allowed in or near tents
- Personal audio gear (Game Boy, CDs, MP3s, etc) except when traveling
