PATROL ACTIVITIES

- Patrol "meetings" where only the Patrol Leader and the Assistant patrol leaders are present do not count towards Honor Patrol.
- If you are going on the trip for a service project, you get 3 points per day per patrol if 50% or more of your patrol is attending. If you have less than 50%, your patrol does not get any points.
- If you are attending an event that is for sheer enjoyment, then you get 3 for the event per patrol. The same attendance restrictions apply as with service projects.

PATROL LEADERS

Patrol leaders need to "weed out" their patrols. If there is an inactive person, the patrol leader must first call this person to try to encourage the person's return. If the member does not return to attending meetings, the patrol leader should notify Mrs. Mary to move the person from their patrol to the zGhosts.
